JOB DUTIES

- Pilot-in-command of SES/SEL aircraft
- Exercise PIC authority to defer flights.

- Lift up to 50 pounds repeatedly throughout the day.
- Perform revenue flights under VFR, 500 feet AGL, over hazardous terrain.
- Safely negotiate hazardous weather such as thunderstorms, fog, wind-shear, and waves.
- Assist National Park rangers with rescue operations, including medical evacuations.
- Coordinate aircraft needs and requests with staff.
- Act as primary contact between the company, lodge employees, park rangers, and customers located on a remote and isolated island with limited communications.
